

Subsidy Request Information

SUMAPX 2022

Intro

To facilitate making your participation within SUMAPX more fruitful, the GGO and ESSF would love to collectively find ways to support sustainable activities. This document contains rules and guidelines for a subsidy setup by GGO. The subsidy is meant for participants of the SUMAP project.

The Subsidy

For each association, a sum of €150 is reserved for subsidies to support the implementation of sustainable activities. This is the maximum amount per association that will be available during the pilot. Associations can apply for their subsidy by submitting proposals about the activities. The subsidy is meant to be a financial stimulation for implementing sustainable activities. Therefore, when an application is accepted, the proposed activity will only be partly subsidized. Applications with expenses exceeding this amount can still request the full subsidy sum.

The activity

The activity itself should be focused on sustainability. This means the proposed activity must follow the following red lines.

- Participants are motivated and efficiently convinced about changes they must make to improve sustainability.
- The activity has a significant positive effect on the ecological footprint.
- The activity does not have to happen in 1 time, but can also be an investment (e.g. hard cups)

The Request

Applications must be submitted at the latest on **May 27th, 2022**. The applications will be reviewed by the GGO and ESSF team and can then be approved or disapproved. The request will take place via the subsidy platform of ESSF at <https://essf.nl/en/about#subsidies> and follow the payment guidelines of the ESSF.
